Digitalisation is an important part of your doctorate thesis? You're looking for an opportunity to gain new perspectives and to see your dissertation from the viewpoints of different specialised fields? You would like to present your work in front of an audience and receive constructive feedback? Then our workshop "Pitch your Research" is just right for you!

Our two day PhD Workshop, organised by the *network INDIGO* and the *BayWISS Verbundkolleg Digitalisierung*, will take place on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of October 2020. The workshop is aimed at doctoral students from all disciplines who are dealing with the topic of digitalisation in their dissertation.

As a participant, you get the chance to present your dissertation in a 10-minute scientific, generally comprehensible presentation to other PhD students. As a presenter, you will receive individual feedback from your colleagues afterwards. The workshop is especially suitable if you're interested in an interdisciplinary exchange in a peer-to-peer setting. We would also like to welcome you if you are a PhD student currently at the beginning of your doctorate.

This year the PhD Workshop will be taking place digitally. The thesis projects will be presented as part of an online live lecture.

Participants will also get the chance to connect and exchange ideas with their colleagues from the INDIGO universities and the *BayWISS Verbundkolleg*. Both dates will provide ample opportunities for networking and interdisciplinary knowledge-sharing.

Are you interested in presenting your dissertation in a short lecture? We're looking forward to receiving your submissions. You can send your abstract (max. 300 words) to the INDIGO offices until 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2020 via e-mail ([info@indigo-netzwerk.de](mailto:info@indigo-netzwerk.de)). The abstract should communicate your key research question, its placement in the context of digitalisation and your applied or planned scientific method.
